**Bemerkung:** Airborne 16:16 on 2 Nov 1944 from North Killingholme to bomb a target in Düsseldorf. Cause of loss not established. Merlin 24 engines. PD255 was delivered to Woodford for Quality Control Check 29 Jul 1944 and handed on to 550 Sqdn Aug 1944. When lost this aircraft had a total of 175 hours.
